Go Everywhere

Rapid Transit systems are essential for residential growth in major metropolitan cities. With the groundbreaking extension of the TTC's Line 1 to VMC, Vaughan and Toronto are the only cities in the GTA with subway access.

Living at Festival means residents are within minutes of North America's award-winning rapid transit system and regional transit, connecting them to the entire GTA and beyond. The VMC Subway Station is designated by Metrolinx as a Mobility Hub, and is accessed by York Regional Transit (YRT), VIVA buses and ZUM transit.

Redfin, a tech-powered real estate firm, ranked the TTC as North America's best transit system for 2019 - outperforming Boston, Philadelphia and Washington DC, as well as Vancouver and Montreal.

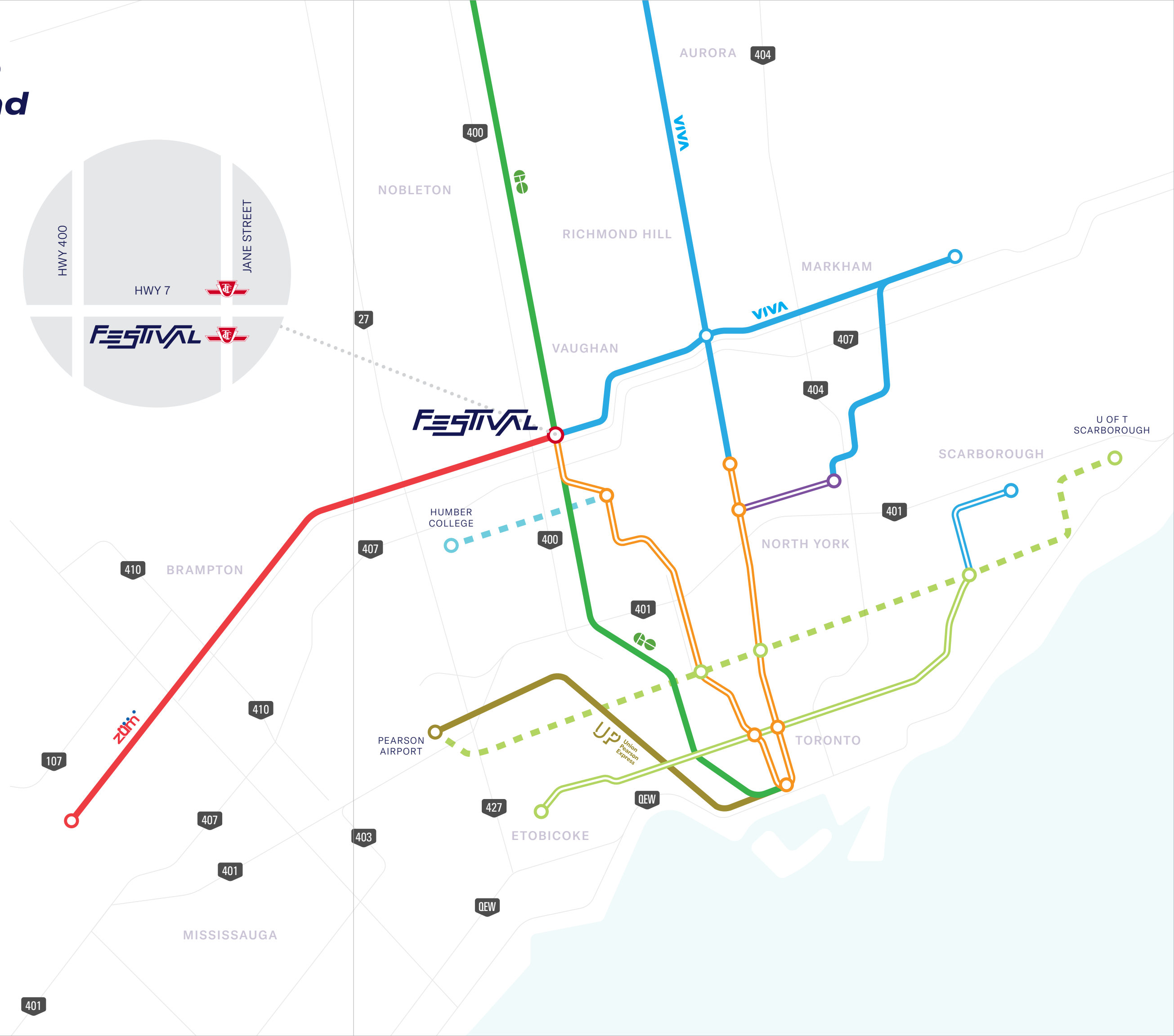

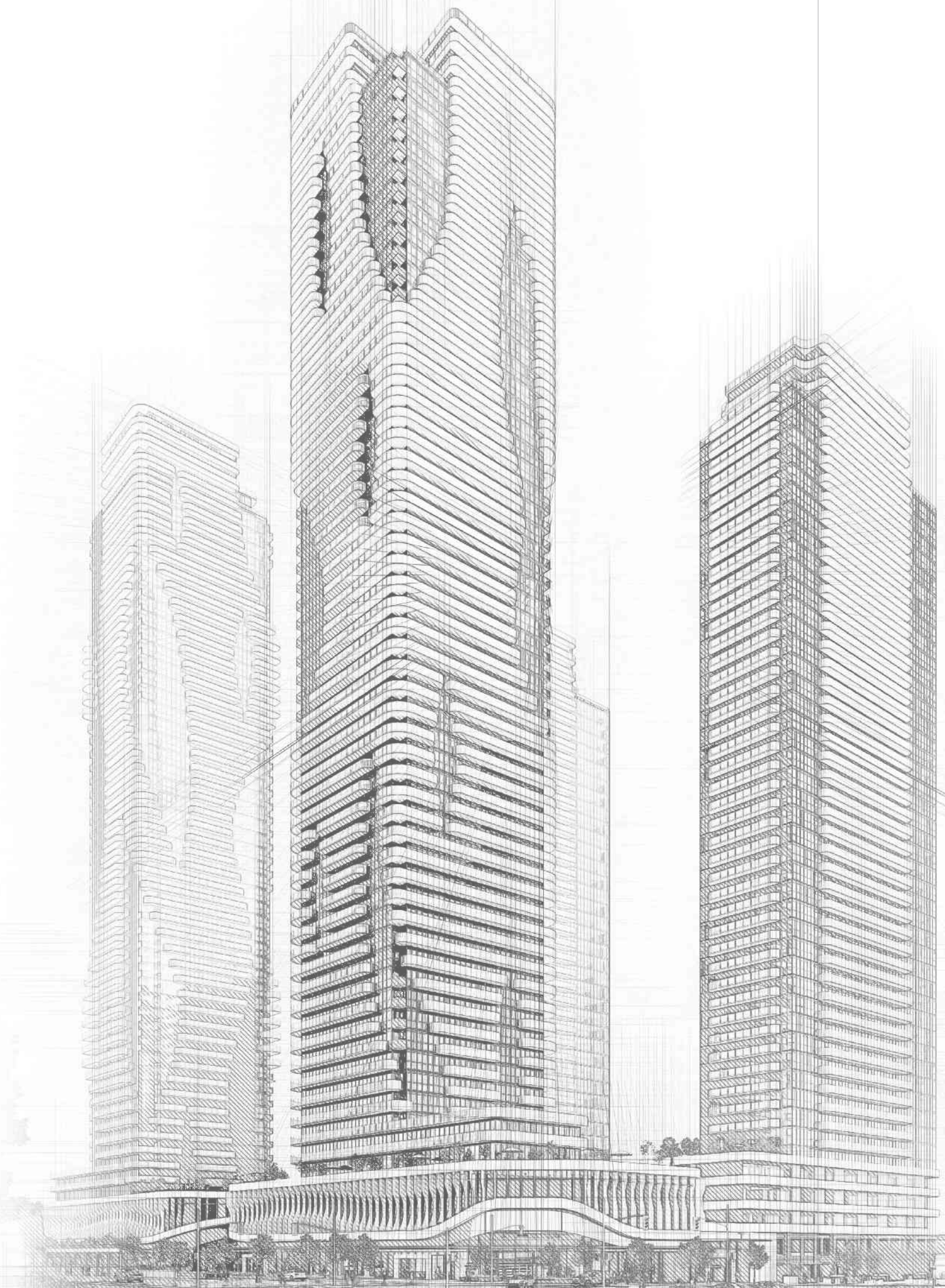

Towers Shaping The Horizon

Anchoring the Festival master plan, four striking towers will rise to shape the skyline of the VMC. Their elegantly interconnected podiums will be organized around a central pedestrian retail mezzanine and plaza – animated with boutique restaurants, an anchor fitness facility and a grocery store. The buildings are dramatically wrapped with sculptural façades that subtly reveal the inner glass towers. At podium level, a series of perforated metal banners are arranged in a pattern that references the movement along the Highway 7 frontage, leading the eye to the entrance of the retail mezzanine.

South VMC is quickly transforming into a prosperous downtown in Vaughan, with Festival designed for a diverse population. Seamless transit access and new commercial development close to major highways create a hub of employment opportunities that will be central to Festival residents.
